Dancers will arrive in Bodyliners and coloured bodysuits. All costume pieces and accessories will be given to the dancers at the venue.

### Micro Mini Age 4-5

- Peacock, Cerise or Black Coloured Cap Sleeve Bodysuit (No buttons, snaps, or zippers)
- Beige slip on jazz shoes
- Beige Bodyliner
- Beige Convertible Dance Tights

#### Mini's Age 6+

- Copen or Black Coloured Cap Sleeve Bodysuit (No buttons, snaps, or zippers)
- Beige slip on jazz shoes
- Beige Bodyliner
- Beige Convertible Dance Tights

### Petite's Age 9+

- Navy or Black Coloured Cap Sleeve Bodysuit (No buttons, snaps, or zippers)
- Beige slip on jazz shoes
- Beige Bodyliner
- Beige Convertible Dance Tights

#### Juniors Age 12+

- Black Bodysuit (Any Style)
- Beige slip on jazz shoes
- Beige Bodyliner
- Beige Convertible Dance Tights

### Seniors Age 14+

- Bodysuit (Any style, Any Colour)
- Beige slip on jazz shoes
- Beige Bodyliner
- Beige Convertible Dance Tights

#### \*Please make sure no undergarments are visible. Tights may act as underwear.

### **Hair Information**

- Long hair 4 & up is to be in a ballet bun on the nape of the neck with no flyaways,
- Short hair is to be positioned neatly away from the face.

#### Makeup Information

Makeup is worn by performers on stage so that the dancer's faces are visible under the stage lights. We recommend wearing makeup as shown on the chart below so that you can see your dancer's smiling face onstage, however, make up is not mandatory.

Hair tied back neatly off of face

## **Makeup Information**

Pink

White eyeshadow

### Eyelid (4 on chart)

Light/Medium Brown eyeshadow

### Creases (5 on chart)

Dark Brown eyeshadow

### Eyeliner (6 on chart)

Black

### Mascara (on top and bottom eyelashes)

Black

True Red
