

Annual Recital Information & Guide

General Information

- Our 5th Annual Recital is on May 13, 2023 at the Seven Oaks Performing Arts Centre (711 Jefferson Ave, Winnipeg, MB).
- We will have 3 shows. Each class/dance will perform in one show.
- The GREEN SHOW will start promptly at 10:00am. Doors will open for audience members at 9:30am.
- The BLUE SHOW will start promptly at 1:00pm. Doors will open for audience members at 12:30pm.
- The PINK SHOW will start promptly at 4:00pm. Doors will open for audience members at 3:30pm.
- If your dancer is in multiple classes or performance company they may perform in multiple shows. With over 260 dancers we try our best to put all classes they take and all family members in the same show but this is not always possible.
- All dancers will perform their choreographed dances for all audience members and other students in costume, in a state of the art performing arts theatre complete with a stage, lights, wings, dressing rooms, raised seating and MORE!
- Please make sure you have the costume, hair & makeup document for your classes as this will be needed for recital day. You can find it on the show hub here.

Recital Packages

- The recital package includes everything you need for a fantastic recital experience!
 - Your recital package is \$70 plus GST for the first dancer in each family and includes:

- Your recital package is \$60 plus GST for each sibling in a family and includes:

- This is a \$250-\$575 value! The recital package fee for each dancer will be posted to your account online on February 9, 2023. You have until February 21, 2023 to pay in your desired payment method (cash, cheque, etransfer). Your account will be auto-drafted the remaining balance on February 21, 2023 using your credit card on file.
- Participation packages are required for every dancer as they include all
 costume pieces and everything else all of our dancers need for a fantastic
 and unforgettable show day experience.
- The participation package fees are non-refundable under any circumstance after fees have been posted on February 9, 2023.
- Dance is a performing art thus the recital is an essential experience for every dancer. Performing on stage provides a golden opportunity to reap the rewards of their hard work and dedication put in throughout the year. The thrill of performing is an exhilarating feeling only achieved on stage. In the terrible circumstance your dancer is not able to attend the recital let us know before February 8, 2023.

Tickets & Recital Gift Packs

 Tickets to the show and recital gift pack can be purchased beginning March 15, 2023 for VIP dancers and March 31, 2023 for all other dancers right here.

- There are no limits on the amount of extra tickets you can purchase. There is however a limited amount of seating for each show and the shows will sell out. It is highly recommended to purchase tickets VERY SOON after sales open. If you wait until the last minute to use your ticket credit and the shows are sold out, the credit will not be reimbursed. You'll receive a promo code closer to ticket sales opening in the weekly email updates to utilise your credit when purchasing tickets.
- Most dancers bring all their supporters to watch their recital performances.
 Grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, neighbours and friends are all welcome but please leave pets at home as our venue does not welcome pets of any kind.

Ticket Pricing:

- Ticket prices will be tiered (different prices for different seats). Prices range from \$16.50 \$25 + taxes and service fees for Early Bird tickets (early bird pricing ends April 28, 2023). Prices range from \$21.50 \$30 + taxes and service fees for regular priced tickets (from April 29, 2023 onward).
- If your immediate family (students that live at the same address) is in more than 1 show, you'll purchase tickets for one show and we'll match the amount of tickets purchased (at the same or lower priced tier) for all other shows they are in for FREE. You'll receive a special promo code closer to ticket sales opening by email to utilise when purchasing tickets if this affects you.

Recital Tshirts

- All dancers will receive a recital tshirt that they will wear as part of their costume for the finale performance in each show they are in.
- Dancers will be able to take home and keep their recital tshirt after the show unlike costumes.
- Performance Company dancers will also wear their recital tshirt as part of their costume for the opening number performance in each show.
- Please fill out <u>this form</u> prior to February 28, 2023 to pick your dancers tshirt size.
 If we do not receive a form for your dancer before this date their tshirt size will be chosen at random.
- Dancers will need to dance in their tshirt so please choose an appropriate size.

Finale Rehearsal

- At the end of each of our shows ALL the dancers in the show will come together onstage to perform a finale.
- As each show involves approximately 100 dancers we'll need to practice this all together before show day to ensure a successful experience for all dancers involved.
- The Finale rehearsal will take place on Saturday May 6, 2023 at the Ecole Edward Schreyer School Gym (85 5th Street South Beausejour, MB) as our studios are not big enough to hold 100 dancers at once.
 - ALL dancers in the GREEN Show will rehearse from 10:00-11:00am.
 - o ALL dancers in the BLUE Show will rehearse from 11:20am-12:20pm.
 - ALL dancers in the PINK Show will rehearse from 12:40-1:40pm.

Parent Meetings

 We will be walking you through all of this important information regarding the Annual Recital in person at parent observation week during your child's regularly scheduled classes from February 12-17, 2023. Please make sure you attend the last 20 minutes of class or come observe the entire class.

RECITAL DAY

<u>Arrival</u>

- Dancers must arrive in full costume with hair and makeup complete. Find costume, hair & make up information for each class <u>here</u>.
- Dancers in multiple dances, please read the spreadsheets below VERY carefully.
 This is the show order for each show. Please arrive in the costume for the dance you will be performing first and bring all of your other costumes with you.
- An arrival schedule for each show is listed below. Please arrive at your ARRIVAL TIME. Please read the schedule VERY carefully as it is NOT in the order the dancers arrive, it is in the order they will be performing in during the show.
- Dancers will be dropped off at their arrival time at the backstage check in table located in the lobby of the Seven Oaks Performing Arts Centre. It won't be hard to find once you enter through the front doors.

During

- Please note that for the safety and privacy of all of our dancers, there will be no
 personal recording of performances permitted. We have hired a professional
 videographer and photographer to record all the recital performances. There is a
 digital video copy of the performances included in your child's participation
 package.
- All dancers will be supervised by our volunteers from the time they arrive until
 they are picked up at the end of the show. Dancers will not be released to their
 parents/guardians until after the show is complete.
- To show the utmost respect for ALL of our dancers it is expected that all

- audience members remain in the audience and enjoy the entire show. Please do not leave in the middle of a show unless it is an emergency. Each show is about 45-60 minutes long.
- We need parent volunteers from each class to supervise dancers backstage. If
 you are interested please send an email to tarantismdance@gmail.com. Classes
 who do not have a parent volunteer may be charged a babysitter fee. Volunteers
 will be able to see their child perform onstage and do not need a ticket for the
 show they are volunteering for.
- Dancers should not bring any personal belongings backstage other than the
 costumes and dance shoes they need for the current show. Parents will need to
 keep all outdoor shoes, jackets, etc. with them. We recommend bringing a
 reusable bag to put your dancers shoes and jackets in before they go backstage.

After

- <u>1</u> parent/guardian from each family will go to the Stage left door (we'll give you directions on how to find this during the show, it's super easy) to collect their dancer(s) after the show is complete. Please bring ID with you.
- Registration for our 2023/24 season will be open online here starting April 17, 2023 for VIP dancers, April 18, 2023 for current performance company dancers who are returning to performance company next season and April 20, 2023 for all other dancers.
- All costumes must be returned to the studio between May 14-19, 2023. You can drop off the costumes during your child's last week of classes (May 14-19, 2023) during their regular class times.

Awards Gala

- We are so excited to be hosting an awards gala to celebrate all of our dancers'
 accomplishments throughout the past season! We have lots of awards to give out
 to our amazing dancers including our dancer of the year awards, and you'll enjoy
 some performances by our performance companies, graduates and all of our
