#### Petite's Age 9+

- Navy or Black Coloured Cap Sleeve Bodysuit (No buttons, snaps, or zippers)
- Beige Toe Thongs
- Beige Bodyliner
- Beige Convertible Dance Tights

### Juniors Age 12+

- Black Bodysuit (Any Style)
- Beige Toe Thongs
- Beige Bodyliner
- Beige Convertible Dance Tights

### Seniors Age 14+

- Bodysuit (Any style, Any Colour)
- Beige Toe Thongs
- Beige Bodyliner
- Beige Convertible Dance Tights

#### \*Please make sure no undergarments are visible. Tights may act as underwear.

- Long hair 4 & up is to be in a ballet bun on the nape of the neck with no flyaways, 3 & under a high ponytail on the crown of the head with curly hair.
- Short hair is to be positioned neatly away from the face.

### Eyeliner (6 on chart)

Black

Black
