



2021 Winter Showcase Guide

General Info

Showcase Date: December 12, 2021

- **What is the winter showcase?**

The winter showcase is an opportunity for all of our students to showcase to their families what they have been working on in class for the first half of the year! Every class will do a 3-6 minute performance that showcases what they do in class each week. This is not a traditional recital, it's more of a sneak peek into all of our classes so you can see what the dancers have been working on in class. There will also be a market with local makers set up for you to finish any last minute holiday shopping as well as food and drinks available.

- **Who participates in the winter showcase?**

All of our students! Except for our 6 week dance & play sessions.

- **Where will the winter showcase be held?**

Brokenhead River Community Hall (320 Veterans Lane Beausejour, MB)

- **What are the COVID-19 safety protocols?**

We'll be following almost identical COVID-19 restrictions and safety protocols as in our classes.

- **All audience members ages 12+** must provide proof of vaccination for COVID-19 prior to entering the facility. You'll need your QR code scanned to be able to enter the facility.
- **All performers ages 18+** must provide proof of vaccination for COVID-19 prior to entering the facility. If a performer would like to enter the audience they are considered an audience member and must provide proof of vaccination if they are 12 years of age or older.
- Please maintain a 6ft distance from others throughout the event.
- Masks are mandatory for everyone ages 5+.
- Please do not attend if you have any symptoms of COVID-19 or are required to quarantine/isolate as per Manitoba Public Health guidelines.
- Our classes have been separated into 3 different shows. We have worked hard to ensure dancers who are in multiple classes and dancers with siblings in other classes are in the same show as much as possible. Please know that with 115 families that have dancers in multiple classes this is not always possible even with our best efforts.

- **When does my dancer perform?**

A performance schedule is on pages 4-6. Your dancer will meet their group in the front lobby at their arrival time and the dancers will perform approximately 10-15 minutes after that.

- **Why is performing an important part of dance?**

Just like you wouldn't want to skip your hockey games and only attend the practices you don't want to miss your dance performances! Performing teaches our dancers confidence, hard work, determination, bravery, leadership, team work, goal setting & more!

- **Can I record the show?**

No. For the safety and privacy of all of our dancers no personal recording of performances is permitted. We have hired a professional videographer to record all the winter showcase performances. Anyone who would like a recording of their shining stars performance is invited to purchase a secure digital copy through the same link as our ticket sales.

Tickets

- **When will tickets go onsale?**

2:30pm on November 19, 2021

- **How do I purchase tickets?**

Tickets will be sold online. A link will be sent to your email address on November 19 at 2:30pm in our regular weekly update emails.

- **Can I purchase tickets at the studio?**

All ticket purchases must be made online through the link provided. We'd be happy to help you with the online ticket purchasing process in person at the studio if needed.

- **How much do tickets cost?**

We have 4 different options:

1. **All Shows Package** includes 2 tickets to all 3 shows and a secure digital recording of all the winter showcase performances. \$115.00
2. **1 Show Package** includes 1 ticket to 1 show of your choice and a secure digital recording of all the winter showcase performances. \$42.00
3. **Single Ticket** includes 1 ticket to 1 show of your choice. \$16.00
4. **Digital Recording Only** includes a secure digital recording of all the winter showcase performances. \$40.00

- **Is there a limit on the amount of tickets I can purchase?**

No. There is no limit on the amount of tickets each dancer can purchase however there are a limited number of tickets available for each show to ensure COVID-19 restrictions are followed.

- **Can my dancer watch the show in the audience?**

Yes, however **all audience members ages 12+** must provide proof of vaccination for COVID-19 prior to entering the facility.

- **Is there a chance that the show my dancer is in will sell out?**

Yes. It seems like everyone wants to get in on the fun at TDC. We suggest purchasing tickets as soon as possible so you are guaranteed tickets.

- **Will my seats be reserved or general admission?**

Our winter showcase will be general admission and a more relaxed feeling than a traditional performing arts show. We invite you to browse the market and grab some food and drinks while the dancers are performing. There will also be seating to enjoy the performances.

The big day!

- **When do we need to arrive at the venue?**

A performance schedule is on pages 4-6. Your dancer will meet their group in the front lobby at their arrival time and the dancers will perform approximately 10-15 minutes after that. You are welcome to watch all the performances in your dancer's show or just your dancer's performance. You can arrive and enjoy the performances and market at anytime throughout your show but please make sure your dancer is in the lobby at their arrival time to meet their group. **Ex:** If your dancer is in the blue show and their arrival time is 11:35am, you can arrive when the blue show performances start at 11:00am and enjoy the performances until 11:35am when you meet your group in the front lobby. OR you can arrive at 11:35am and just watch your dancer's group perform.

- **Where do I drop off my dancer?**

One of our teachers will meet them at the front door so just bring them to the front entrance just like all of our audience members.

- **What is the drop off & pick up process?**

Our teachers will be meeting the dancers at the front door at their arrival time. We'll take care of them throughout their performance. After they are finished performing you'll meet your dancer at the front entrance where you dropped them off. We have your contact information on hand if anything happens.

- **What does my dancer wear to the winter showcase?**

Their dance wear! We are showcasing what it's like to be in class each week so all the dancers will wear their dress code items to perform in. We have all of their what to wear, makeup and hair information available on the show hub on our website [here](#).

- **Can I go in the dressing room with my dancer?**

For the safety of all of our dancers we need to limit the amount of people allowed in the dressing room area. Parents are not allowed in the dressing room area. The dancers will be in the dressing room with their teacher just like at dance class. All of the dancers are to arrive dressed and ready to go.

- **What kind of makeup does my dancer wear?**

- **If I'm coming to multiple shows do I have to leave the venue in between shows?**

Yes, all audience members will need to leave the venue and re-enter between shows.
