



## *Annual Mid Season Showcase Information & Guide*

### General Information

- Our 3rd Annual Mid Season Showcase is on December 2, 2023 at the Brokenhead River Community Hall (320 Veterans Lane Beausejour, MB) and will begin at 9:00am.
- We will have 2 shows. Each class/dance will perform in one show.
- The GREEN SHOW will start promptly at 9:45am. Doors will open for early entrance ticket holders at 9:00am and regular ticket holders at 9:15am.
- The BLUE SHOW will start promptly at 12:30pm. Doors will open for early entrance ticket holders at 11:45am and regular ticket holders at 12:00pm
- If your dancer is in multiple classes or performance company they may perform in multiple shows. We try our best to put all classes dancers take and all family members in the same show but this is not always possible.
- The mid season showcase is an opportunity for all of our students to showcase what they have been working on in class for the first half of the year! All dancers will perform their choreographed dances for all audience members and other students in costume. There will also be a market with local makers set up for you to finish (or start) any holiday shopping as well as a pancake breakfast and pictures with Santa.
- All of our foundational and preschool program dancers will be performing.

# BEFORE Mid Season Showcase Day

## Tickets

- Tickets to the show can be purchased beginning **November 1, 2023 for Gold Level Club TDC dancers**, **November 2, 2023 for Silver Level Club TDC dancers**, **November 3, 2023 for Bronze Level TDC dancers** and **November 5, 2023 for all other dancers & the public** right [here](#).
- There are no limits on the amount of extra tickets you can purchase. There is however a limited amount of seating for each show and the shows will sell out. It is highly recommended to purchase tickets VERY SOON after sales open.
- Most dancers bring all their supporters to watch their recital performances. Grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, neighbours and friends are all welcome but please leave pets at home as our venue does not welcome pets of any kind.
- Ticket Pricing:
  - **Ticket prices will be tiered (different prices for different times of entry into the venue). Prices range from \$10 - \$25 + taxes and service fees for Early Bird tickets (early bird pricing ends November 11, 2023). Prices range from \$20 - \$35 + taxes and service fees for regular priced tickets (from November 12, 2023 onward).**
  - If your immediate family (students that live at the same address) is in more than 1 show, you'll purchase tickets for one show and we'll match the amount of tickets purchased (at the same or lower priced tier) for all other shows they are in for FREE. You'll enter your dancer's name during the checkout process and the discount will be applied automatically. Please note, it will look like you'll be charged full price for all tickets until the very end of the checkout process.

## Gift Packs

- After choosing your tickets you'll have the option to purchase gift packs for your performers and loved ones! We've loved having Pennyweight Market and The Floral Merchant join us at all of our big performances for the past couple years so you can get flowers and candy for your dancers. By purchasing your gift packs when purchasing tickets it'll really help them out with pre-planning how many gifts to prepare for the show and some of our packages include some super awesome exclusive TDC Merch at an amazing discount.

- **PLUS we'll be donating a portion of the proceeds from every gift pack purchase to our Performance Company Travel Fund.** All donations received towards the performance company travel fund will be split equally amongst all dancers participating in our next performance trip which is to New York City in 2024! This will help offset the investment required to travel, perform and experience this once in a lifetime opportunity for all dancers and help more students be able to participate. You'll also have an option to just make a donation to the Performance Company travel fund.

### Pancake Breakfast

- There will be a pancake breakfast at the Mid Season Showcase for \$10 which includes pancakes, breakfast sausages, coffee, tea and juice. So you can enjoy a meal while watching the performances just like at a dinner theatre!
- Pancake breakfasts can be purchased in advance when ordering your tickets and gift packs.
- **PLUS we'll be donating a portion of the proceeds from every breakfast purchase to our Performance Company Travel Fund.** All donations received towards the performance company travel fund will be split equally amongst all dancers participating in our next performance trip which is to New York City in 2024! This will help offset the investment required to travel, perform and experience this once in a lifetime opportunity for all dancers and help more students be able to participate. You'll also have an option to just make a donation to the Performance Company travel fund.

### Performance Tshirts

- All dancers will receive a performance tshirt that they will wear as part of their costume for the mid season showcase.
- Dancers will be able to take home and keep their performance tshirt after the show unlike other parts of their costumes.
- **IMPORTANT!** Dancers will have to wear their performance tshirt again at the end of year recital in May. Please do not lose it, dirty or wear it again until **after the recital in May**. If any tshirts need to be replaced the cost is \$30.
- Please fill out [this form](#) prior to October 21, 2023 to pick your dancers tshirt size. If we do not receive a form for your dancer before this date their tshirt size will be chosen at random. Dancers will have to wear their performance t-shirt again at the end of year recital in May, make sure you choose an appropriate size to both dance in and account for growth if necessary.

## Parent Meetings

- We will be walking you through all of this important information regarding the Mid Season Showcase in person at parent participation week during your child's regularly scheduled classes from October 15-20, 2023. Please make sure you attend the last 20 minutes of class or come participate in the entire class alongside your dancer.

## Mid Season Showcase DAY

### Arrival

- Dancers must arrive in their regular class attire (their bodysuits, tights, correct shoes, etc.) with their performance t-shirt on overtop with their hair and make up complete.
- **Performance Company dancers will arrive in their costumes for their performance company dances and regular class attire for their other classes depending on what they perform first in the show.**
- Dressing rooms are located in the Brokenhead Room. **Dancers will be dropped off at their arrival time at the doors to the Brokenhead Room.** The Show will take place in the Beausejour Room, **audience members will enter through the Beausejour Room doors.**
- Dancers in multiple dances, please read the spreadsheets below VERY carefully. This is the show order. Please arrive in the class attire for the dance style you will be performing first and bring all of your other attire (specifically different coloured tights and different shoes) with you. If possible layer your tights overtop of each other (and your bodysuit) to make quick changes faster as most quick changes will need to be done in under 30 seconds.

### During

- Please note that for the safety and privacy of all of our dancers, there will be no personal recording of performances permitted. We have hired a professional videographer and photographer to record all the performances. A digital copy of all videos and photos will be sent to all TDC dancers approximately 3-4 weeks after the show, courtesy of TDC.
- All dancers will be supervised by our volunteers from the time they arrive until they are picked up at the end of the show. Dancers will not be released to their parents/guardians until after the show is complete.
- To show the utmost respect for ALL of our dancers it is expected that all audience members remain in the audience and enjoy the entire show. Please do not leave in the middle of a show unless it is an emergency. Each show is about 45-60 minutes long. Audience members are free to grab a pancake breakfast or shop in the market during the performances. It's kind of like taking a vacation to a

European Christmas market and our dancers are the performers!

- We need parent volunteers from each class to supervise dancers backstage. If you are interested please send an email to tarantismdance@gmail.com. Classes who do not have a parent volunteer may be charged a babysitter fee. Volunteers will be able to see their child perform and do not need a ticket for the show they are volunteering for.
- Dancers should not bring any personal belongings backstage other than the costumes and dance shoes they need for the current show. Parents will need to keep all outdoor shoes, jackets, etc. with them. We recommend bringing a reusable bag to put your dancers shoes and jackets in before they go backstage.

## *After*

- **1 parent/guardian from each family** will go to the Brokenhead Room door (where you dropped your dancer off) to collect their dancer(s) after the show is complete. Please bring ID with you.
