



## Spring Showcase Information & Guide

### General Information

- Our show is **June 27th 2024 at 6pm.**
- Doors will open to the public at 5:30pm.
- Dancers will arrive at 5:15.
- All dancers will perform their choreographed dances for all audience members and other students in costume, complete with glamorous hair and makeup.
- Please make sure you have the costume, hair & makeup document for your classes as this will be needed for recital day. You can find it on the show hub.

### Tickets & Recital Gift Packs

- Tickets to the show and recital gift pack can be purchased beginning June 10th, Tickets will cost \$15.00 (+tax). Every attendee will need a ticket, no children in laps.
- There are no limits on the amount of extra tickets you can purchase. There is however a limited amount of seating for each show and the shows will sell out. It is highly recommended to purchase tickets VERY SOON after sales open.
- **Backstage volunteers do not need a ticket.**
- Most dancers bring all their supporters to watch their recital performances. Grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, neighbours and friends are all welcome but please leave pets at home as our venue does not welcome pets of any kind.
- We will have gift packs for sale at various price points to fit every budget, on the ticketing website and at the door.

### Arrival

- Dancers must arrive in full costume with hair and makeup complete. Find costume, hair & make up information for each class [here](#).
- **Dancers in multiple dances, please arrive in the costume for the dance you will be performing first and bring all of your other costumes with you.**
- **The arrival time for all dancers is 5pm.**
- **Dancers will be dropped off at their arrival time at the doors across from the auditorium at Ecole Edward Schreyer School.** It won't be hard to find once

you enter through the doors.

- Dancers will be dropped off at arrival time. Doors will open for the audience at 5:30 regardless of arrival time.
- **Dancers should not bring any personal belongings backstage** other than the costumes and dance shoes they need for the current show. Parents/Guardians will need to keep all outdoor shoes, jackets, etc. with them. We recommend bringing a reusable bag to put your dancers shoes and jackets in before they go backstage. **Any belongings apart from costumes, water bottle, and dance shoes will be left with parents/guardians at drop off.** Parents/Guardians are expected to hold onto outdoor shoes and ALL belongings.

### During

- Please note that for the safety and privacy of all of our dancers, photos and videos taken during the performance absolutely must not be posted to any social media. There will be no flash photography or videos permitted at any time.
- All dancers will be supervised by our volunteers from the time they arrive until they are picked up at the end of the show. Dancers will not be released to their parents/guardians until after the show is complete.
- To show the utmost respect for ALL of our dancers it is expected that all audience members remain in the audience and enjoy the entire show. Please do not leave in the middle of a show unless it is an emergency. Each show is about 30-45 minutes long.
- Enjoy the show! Our dancers have been working on their dances very hard these past weeks and are ecstatic to share their creativity with the people they love most- you!
- We need parent volunteers from each class to supervise dancers backstage. If you are interested please send an email to [tinfo@tarantism.com](mailto:tinfo@tarantism.com). Classes who do not have a parent volunteer may be charged a babysitter fee. Volunteers will be able to see their child perform onstage and do not need a ticket for the show they are volunteering for.

### After

- **1 parent/guardian from each family** will collect their dancer(s) after the show is complete. Please bring ID with you. Dancers will be released one at a time (with the exception of dancers in the same household) to their parent/guardian.
- **All costumes must be returned immediately following the performance.**
- Bask in the post performance glow! Enjoy talking with your dancer about their experience and about how much fun each of you had.
